ELD Orders Have Been Placed Remember These Key Dates

November 15, 2017

All ELD devices must be installed. You will run dual logs, ELD and paper (paper will be your legal copy for the first 30 days). This will allow you time to adjust to how the ELD system works. You are required however to treat the ELD as if it were your only log. Practice makes perfect. Your ELD Team is here to help you!

December 18, 2017

We are officially off and running! ELD mandate is in full effect. Remember you have a full support staff readily available to help you.

You MUST have with you at all times
(These will be supplied to you):

- (1) ELD Device Instruction Card
- (2) Blank logbook in case your device malfunctions
